

Troop 220 E-mail Acceptable Use Policy (AUP)

E-mail is a powerful communication tool and an essential means of keeping Troop members and parents informed of ongoing activities. However, as with any tool, discretion needs to be applied to ensure appropriate use.

1. Troop Newsletter correspondence should only be originated by the adult leader responsible for publication and distribution of the Newsletter.
2. Senders should ensure that the content of any email correspondence is consistent with the ideals of Scouting (Trustworthy, friendly, courteous...etc.)
3. The Troop e-mail list shall not be used for non-scouting communications (i.e., marketing, etc.)
4. The Troop e-mail list shall not be used send insulting or discriminatory messages and content.
5. Recipients to broadly distributed emails should use discretion to determine whether or not selecting "reply all" when replying to an email is appropriate.

Disciplinary action due to violation of the e-mail AUP may include, but is not limited to, suspension of posting privileges or removal from all future Troop e-mails. The Troop Committee shall have the final decision on disciplinary action.
